Home Learning

Reading: Reading is such an important part of the curriculum and it is essential that your child continues to read at home regularly. Although there are opportunities to read for pleasure in school, this needs to be carried on at home. Please encourage your child to be reading regularly at home every day. They can choose to read a book from home, or the book chosen from school if they prefer. Please also make sure they are recording their reading in reading records too.

Times Tables: We are continuing to progress up the maths mountain this year and it is great to see the hard work and perseverance of each pupil. We are still having weekly tests on the mountain. Year Four will be having their 'Multiplication Times Table Check' in June. It is very pleasing to see the progress made by all the Year Fours in Rowan Class and would like to see them persevere and carry this on for this term in preparation. Your child should know how to practise for this test at home and would like to see them do this please.

Spelling: Every pupil will have access to Spelling Shed at home where they can practise the week's spellings. Please practise on this regularly ready for a Hive Game every Friday.

Other Information

- PE days for Rowan Class will be **Wednesday** and **Fridays** this term. Both PE sessions will be outdoors and, since the weather is getting warmer, please make sure your child has the appropriate PE kit and footwear. Sun cream too please!
