Uniform Policy

We believe that wearing a uniform is a way of showing pride in the school and encouraging a sense of belonging. We know that when pupils look good, they feel good about themselves, and they produce their best work. Parents' support for our policy is expected.

Uniform:

Grey trousers or shorts Maroon polo shirt with school logo/ Plain Maroon polo shirt Maroon sweatshirt with school logo Plain grey or black socks (not trainer socks) Black Shoes	Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers Maroon polo shirt with school logo / Plain Maroon polo shirt Maroon sweatshirt with school logo White or grey socks or grey tights Black shoes – lace up or with straps For summer – red & white summer dress
Trainers, ballet or pump-type shoes are not acceptable for school wear. In the interest of Health and Safety, school shoes must be closed toes and be secured across the bridge of the foot.	

Please Note:

- From September 2026- Jumper/Cardigans with school logo, Polo shirt with school logo (1 at least for school trips/events) and P.E t-shirt will be compulsory. Book Bags will be optional. For KS1 if you do not wish to purchase a book bag, please send children in with a small toddler size rucksack, big enough to hold their reading books and a drink only. Thank you
- Trousers must be of an appropriate material i.e. not denim, cord, tracksuit or leggings/jersey trousers, and must be of a tailored appearance.
- Skirts, pinafores and summer dresses should be of a reasonable length.
- Children may wear watches and simple stud earrings, maximum of one per ear, providing they can remove the earrings themselves for PE lessons.
- Dyed hair is not permitted.
- Hairstyles and haircuts which are deemed too extreme such as tramlines and shaved heads (no shorter than a number 2) are not permitted.
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back with a plain hair band.
- Nail varnish, make up and stick on tattoos are not permitted.

Bags:

- Due to the lack of space in our school lockers, Children must only have a book bag (KS1), or a **small** bag for their lunch boxes/ water bottles.

PE Kits:

All children wear PE kit on P.E. days with the exception of Reception children who change into their PE kit and keep their kits in school in a clearly-named drawstring PE bag. (Does not have to be school branded)
